INTRODUCTION

The conference to be co-organised by the Malaysian Historical Society (MHS) and International Institute of Islamic Thought and Civilisation (ISTAC) on 3-4 September 2019. The conference would be held at ISTAC, 24, Persiaran Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin, Bukit Tunku, 50480 Kuala Lumpur.

BACKGROUND

The national historical societies of the Philippines, Indonesia and Malaysia have an ongoing cooperation project of hosting an annual conference on the history and culture of the Malay Archipelago on a rotational basis since 2015 under the umbrella of the International Council for Historical – Cultural Cooperation in Southeast Asia (ICHCC-SEA). The first conference was held in Manila, the Philippines (27-29 August, 2015), the second in Bukit Tinggi, Indonesia (26-29 November, 2015) the third in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia (9-10 August, 2016), the fourth in Manila (14-16 September, 2017) and the fifth in Bali (1-4 October, 2018), Indonesia. In 2019 it will be the turn of Kuala Lumpur again (6th conference). Normally the respective National Historical Society of the countries would cooperate with a relevant institution in the country concerned to host the conference.

RATIONALE AND OBJECTIVES

Rationale:

The period extending from the beginning of the sixteenth century until the Second World War is identified with the Western colonization of the Malay world. This is the age of globalization of the colonial economy, resulting in the globalization of agricultural goods and the globalization of people that affected the region. It also saw the coming of Western ideas like secularism, modernism, nationalism and the nation-state, capitalism, communism, and modern science and technology. Their impact on the life and thought of the Malay people was profound. Western colonialism had impacted the development of civilisation in the Malay Archipelago in numerous ways. However, this important period of the region's history is little known to many people. It is only proper that the younger generations are encouraged to better understand the civilisational legacy bequeathed to them that resulted from the encounter and interactions between modern Western and the pre-colonial indigenous civilisations in their own region.

Objectives:

- To better understand the civilizational challenges faced by peoples in the respective countries during the colonial era.
- To deepen our understanding of the Islamic political upheavals toward promoting peace and the Islamic Renaissance in the Archipelago.
- To highlight the significance of circumnavigation of the World to local history.
- To promote cooperation and researches in history and civilization among member countries.

THEME

Colonial period in the Malay Archipelago: Civilizational Issues.

SUB-THEMES

- a. The coming of the colonialists
- b. Civilization in the perspective of Western colonial powers.

- c. Uprising of the Muslims against colonialists
- d. The significance of circumnavigation by Magellan and Panglima Awang (Enrique) to history.
- e. The colonialist education and administration
- f. Islamic traditionalism and reformation movement.
- g. Political ideals of the national heroes.

PAPER PRESENTERS

Paper presenters will be invited by Malaysian Historical Society from The Philippines, Indonesia and Malaysia in line with the tradition of ICHCC-SEA cooperation. In addition, nine paper presenters will be invited by ISTAC.
